

Annual Report of Students Satisfaction Survey (2018-2019)

According to responses given by the students, it is observed the most of the teachers are performing their duties sincerely and punctually. Their class control is up to the mark. Teachers are having thorough knowledge about their subject. It is also found the teachers are motivating students regarding their course work as well as in their further studies. They are in favour of completing syllabus. 23 teachers out of 35 are above 80% i.e. 'A' grade. 10 faculty members out of 35 have secured 'B' grade i.e. very good. That's why it becomes clear the most of the regular faculty members belong to A grade and their feedback is excellent.

The present curriculum is excellent. Most of the respondents are of the opinion that there is vast scope in improving library facilities and outdoor games facilities. Similarly general administration and discipline has been maintained properly but still it needs improvement over it. Infrastructure facilities of the college and laboratories are in good condition. Thus most of the respondents are of the view that the curriculum is up to the mark.

Few respondents suggested regarding cleanliness such as lavatory and classrooms as well as college uniform are essential.

Regarding attendance of the college students, the committee found that some students are not attending classes regularly. Hence, the committee unanimously decided to increase attendance of the students in the classrooms. It suggested to the office to display the names of the students on the notice board. Similarly the committee decided to send SMS and letters to the students who often remain absent and whose attendance is below eighty percent. As a result of this action, ration of the present students in the classrooms has increased and more than eighty percent students appeared for university examination.
